A 10% deposit is required with a new student's enrollment contract. This deposit is held until senior year when you may apply it to your student's Senior Activity Fee, or to the last tuition payment due in a student's senior year. Alternatively, you may choose to donate your deposit back to St. Johns as a charitable gift. The deposit can be refunded if the School receives written indication that a student will not be returning to St. Johns.

## Additional Expenses

**Annual Giving.** In addition to tuition, St. Johns relies on voluntary financial contributions to support our excellent faculty, programs, services, and facilities.

**Books.** Costs vary by grade level and course.

**Bus Transportation.** Available as needed, one-way or round trip. Fees vary. Learn more at [sjcds.net/bus](http://sjcds.net/bus).

**Senior Activity Fee.** A one-time fee of \$1,000 supports graduation, senior trip, and other senior activities.

**Technology.** Digital Resource Fee (Grades 1-5: \$200, Grades 6-8: \$275, Grades 9-12: \$400); iPad required for all students in Grades 6-8; iPad or Apple laptop required for Grades 9-12.

**Uniforms.** All students are required to wear approved uniforms, available at [landsend.com/school](http://landsend.com/school) or in the School's Spirit Store.

**Yearbook.** \$75 annually

**New Student Fees.** All new students are assessed two additional fees: The Building Fee is a one-time, non-refundable \$850 fee required of all new students; the Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) is a tuition insurance plan required of all new students and available as an option for all returning students at the rate is 2.5% of net tuition.

## Financial Aid

Need-based financial aid is available and, if awarded, is credited to the student's account. Financial aid applications must be submitted every year.
