RE: Fall Athletic Procedures for Basketball Fans and Teams

St. Johns Country Day School has safety protocols and policies in place for the health and safety of our athletes, coaches, and fans. We kindly ask that fans of St. Johns and visiting teams adhere to the policies in place. Athletic directors, please send a copy of this information to your Head of School, fall coaches, and team parents.

Basketball and Indoor Events Policies for Fans

- Up to 20 visiting team spectators will be permitted at each home contest:
 - Guest pass lists must be sent to tlivingston@sjcds.net no later than noon on game day.
 - Spectators are limited to athletes' immediate families and will sit together in pods.
 - All guests will be temperature-checked prior to admittance.
 - Face coverings are required upon entrance and throughout the match.
 - Unless siblings are playing, all fans will exit immediately after the match is over so that the 20 spectators for the next match can be admitted.
 - There will be a \$5 charge for all spectators.
- All family members attending contests should sit together in a pod.
- Masks are required upon entry and kept on throughout the event.
- Temperature screenings will take place in the gym lobby before entering. Spectators with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be admitted.
- Hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the gym.
- Concessions will operate at a limited level.
- Restrooms in the gym lobby will be available.
- All spectators will arrive through the gym lobby and exit out the side door

Basketball and Indoor Events Policies for Teams

- Visiting teams will arrive dressed and ready to play. Locker rooms will not be available.
- No handshakes before or after contests.
- All visiting teams will temperature-check prior to arriving at St. Johns.
- Visiting teams should supply their own water.
- No switching benches between sets.
- Maintain social distancing on the bench.
- Attending personnel is limited to home team scorer and timer. Visiting team's scorer and statistician are deemed non-essential personnel and will need to find an alternate location.
- No touch rule—Athletes should refrain from high fives and other physical contact with teammates, opposing players, and coaches.
